Those wanting to volunteer must register and receive a badge before they can help. The badge will be used for volunteer check in and check out and will also need to be worn while in the city. To assist with the registration process, people are asked to bring their driver's license or other state-issued ID.

Volunteer efforts will focus on helping residents pick up yard debris. Those who help are asked to wear proper clothing such as jeans, long sleeve shirts, gloves, boots and eye protection. For safety reasons, volunteers should NOT wear open-toed shoes.
